Guilfest 2009

General Information

**GuilFest 2009,
The 3 day music festival, now in its 18th year, will be on
10th 11th and 12th of July 2009.**

Previous acts that have played at GuilFest include Paul Weller, Madness, UB40, Fun Loving Criminals, Simple Minds, Blondie, Pulp, James, Levellers, The Magic Numbers, Bowling For Soup, British Sea Power, Fightstar and many more.

GuilFest is located in the superb setting of Stoke Park in the heart of Guildford, Surrey. Once there you will receive training to work in various areas over the festival week. These may include one of the 7 stages of music, comedy and theatre, the kidzone, back stage, traffic control, entry points and many other areas.

As well as the 3 days the festival is on, there will be some stewarding required from Wednesday 8th till Tuesday 14th July to help with site set up and take down.

Stewards will also be provided with a stewards only camp site (Tents Only) situated in the beautiful Jubilee Wood (on the festival site). Caravans are **NOT ALLOWED** on site. There is a very limited area in the general public campsite for steward wishing to bring a camper van and these spaces **must be booked prior to the festival**. Please note that ONLY stewards may camp in the stewards area. Stewards wishing to camp with family, friends, children will have to camp on the main campsite.

There are no showers on site, but there is a state of the art sports complex (the spectrum) and an open air swimming pool (the Lido) which are next to Stoke Park which do have showers for a small charge.

At the end of each shift a free hot meal will be provided by the GuilFest canteen. These meals will only be provided for shifts on the Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
